**Key Message**

- ✓ On weekly basis, the national average wholesale prices for sorghum, beans, rice and maize increased by 4%, 3%, 2% and 1% respectively while the price for round potato decreased by 1%.
- ✓ **Maize:** Highest prices were observed in Mwanza, Kigoma, Bukoba, Mtwara and Dar es salaam (Temeke). Lowest prices were recorded in Iringa Urban, Dodoma (Kibaigwa), Sumbawanga and Arusha.
- ✓ **Rice:** Highest prices were observed in Ilala, Arusha, Iringa and Mtwara. Lowest prices were recorded in Kigoma and Sumbawanga.
- ✓ Trends in markets of individual commodities are basically determined by supply and demand on a given time. However, prices declines are observed due to start of harvesting period to almost of producing regions.
