Weekly Market Bulletin

05th February – 09th February 2024

Key Messages

Food crops: wholesale prices for food crops this week have been varying at different rates compared to price level last week. Price of round potato and sorghum decreased by 12.5% and 6.7% respectively. while prices of maize, rice, beans, bulrush millet and finger millet remained constant.

Horticulture: The period of 02nd – 07th February, 2024 prices for horticultural crops in various markets have changed at different rates. Price of green pepper increased by 1.4% while price of onions, pineapple, tomato and watermelon decreased by 4.1%, 3.2%, 2.6% and 0.5% respectively and price of cucumber remain constant.

Cocoa: Total sales were 8,453,900 kilograms with a total value of TZS 76 billion for the week ended 29th January, 2024.

Cashew nut: Until 05th January 2023/24 trade season total sales of raw cashew nut was 241,477,696 kilograms with a total value of TZS 433 billion.
