Weekly Market Bulletin

13th -17th November 2023

Key Messages

Food crops: Wholesale prices for food crops this week have been varying at different rates compared to price levels last week. Price of round potato, bulrush millet, maize, finger millet and beans increased by 5.7%, 3.2%,1.8%,1.4% and 0.4% respectively, while price of sorghum and rice decreased by 4.4%, and 0.6% respectively.

Horticulture: The period of 10th – 15th November, 2023 prices for horticultural crops in various markets have changed at different rates. Price of tomato, green pepper and cucumber increased by 17.5, 3.4% % and 2.5% respectively while prices of pineapple, watermelon, and onions decreased by 14.3%,10.2% and 1.8% respectively.

Cocoa: Total sales were 5,830,230 kilograms with a total value of TZS 49 billion for the week ended 13th November, 2023.
