## **Weekly Market Bulletin**

21 – 25 November, 2022

# **Key Messages**

Food crops: Wholesale prices for food crops this week have been increasing and decreasing at different rates compared to price levels last week. Prices of rice, sorghum and bulrush millet increased by an average of 0.7%, 0.6% and 0.5% respectively, while prices of finger millet, beans, maize and round potatoes decreased by 4.1%, 0.9%, 0.7% and 0.6% respectively.

Horticulture: The period of 17 - 23 November, 2022 price for horticultural crops have changed at different rates compared to price levels last week. Prices of tomato, pineapple, water melon and cucumber have increased by 6.1%, 4.3%, 1.0% and 0.4% respectively, while prices of onion and green pepper have decreased by 4.1% and 4.0% respectively.

Cocoa: Total sales were 6,018,936 kilograms with a total value of TZS 24.8 Billion for the week ended 21st November, 2022.

**Cotton:** Total sales were 174,114,993 kilograms for week ended 23<sup>rd</sup> October, 2022.

**Coffee:** Total sales were 38,390,316 kilograms with a total value of USD 102.7 million for the week ended 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2022.

Cashew nut: Until 20th November, 2022 trade season total sales of raw cashew nut was 89,658,727 kilograms with a total value of TZS 169.8 Billion.
