Weekly Market Bulletin

November 22-26, 2021

Key Messages

This week, wholesale prices for food crops have increased slightly compared to price levels last week (table 1). Some variations in the prices of crops were observed across the markets (Table 2).

Prices for maize, rice and beans rose by an average of 2.9%, 2.0% and 1.9% respectively. Price for finger millet and round potato increased at the same rate of 0.4%. price for sorghum and bulrush millet decreases by 1.1%.

Coffee: Total sales were 43,698,086 kilograms with a total value of USD 118 million for the week ended 22th November, 2021

Cocoa: Total sales were 5,479,180 kilograms with a total value of TZS 26 billion for the week ended 22nd November, 2021.

Cashew nut: Until 24th November, 2021, trade season total sale of raw cashew nuts was 161,796,299 kilograms with a total value of TZS 350 billion.

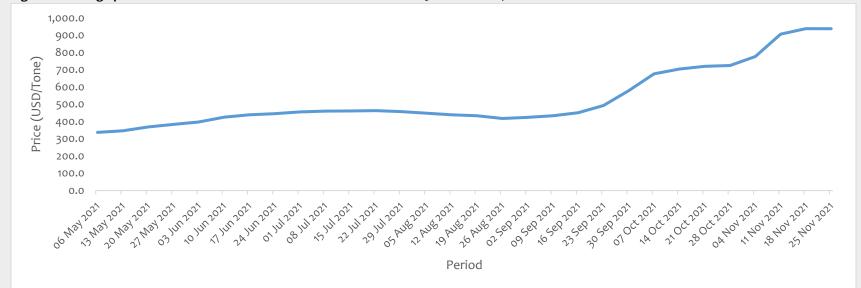


Figure 2: Average price trend of UREA in the world market as season of 25th November, 2021

Fertilizer: Until 25th November, 2021 average price trend of DAP in the world market has slightly increased by 0.07% while average price of UREA remained constant compared to last week average price (figure 1 and figure 2)

A weather report released by the meteorological authority shows rainfall (November, 2021-April, 2022) is anticipated to be below average in several areas (Annex 1). This might result in the rise of price of food crops.

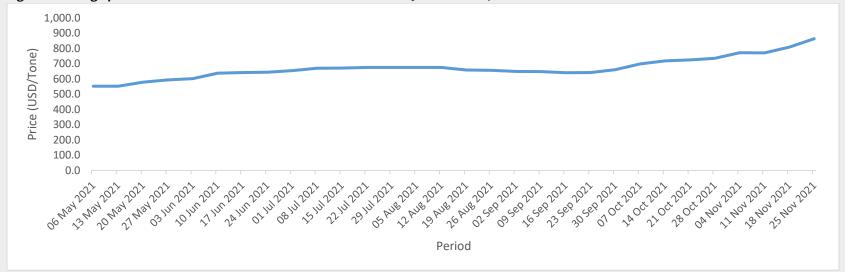

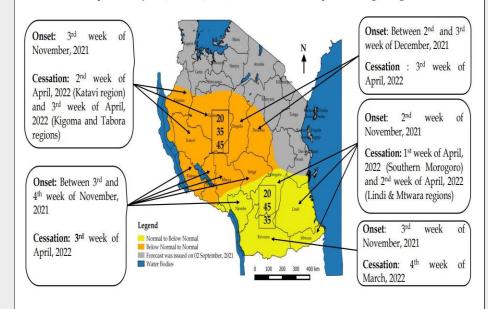
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NOVEMBER, 2021 - APRIL, 2022 (MSIMU) RAINFALL OUTLOOK

During the period of November 2021 to April, 2022, elevated chance of below normal to normal rains is expected in Kigoma, Tabora, Katavi, Singida, Dodoma, Rukwa, Songwe, Mbeya and Iringa regions. However, normal to below normal rains are expected in Njombe, Ruvuma, Lindi, Mtwara and southern part of Morogoro region.

Ushauri na tahadhari umetolewa kwa wadau wa sekta mbalimbali wanaotumia taarifa za hali ya hewa katika utekelezaji wa majukumu yao kama vile kilimo na usalama wa chakula, mifugo na uvuvi, maliasili, wanyamapori na utalii, nishati na maji, usafirishaji (nchi kavu, kwenye maji na angani), mamlaka za miji, afya, sekta binafsi pamoja na menejimenti za maafa.
