## Weekly Market Bulletin 30<sup>th</sup> December, 2024 03<sup>rd</sup> January, 2025

### **Key Messages**

**Food crops**: Wholesale prices for food crops this week have been varying at different rates compared to price levels of last week. Prices of round potato, rice, sorghum and bulrush millet decreases by 9.1%, 9.5%, 11.8% and 16.7% respectively. Prices of beans increased by 3.6%. While prices of maize and finger millet remained unchanged.

**Cocoa:** Until  $02^{nd}$ December 2024/2025 trade season, total sales of cocoa were 5,676,510 kilograms with a total value of TZS 111 Billion.

Coffee: The total sales were 55,563,495.73 kilograms with a total value of USD 250 million for the week ended 13rd December, 2024.
