Weekly Market Bulletin

20th - 24th January, 2025

Key Messages

Food crops: Wholesale prices for food crops this week have been varying at different rates compared to price levels of last week. Price of finger millet increased by 4.5% while prices of sorghum and beans decreased by 6.7% and 3.4% respectively. Prices of maize, rice, bulrush millet, and round potato remained unchanged.

Cocoa: Until 13th January 2024/2025 trade season, total sales of cocoa were 6,409,200 kilograms with a total value of TZS 126 billion.
