Key Messages

✓ On weekly basis, the National average wholesale prices for maize, dry beans round potatoes sorghum and rice decreased by 1, 3, 3, 4 and 6 percent respectively.

✓ **Horticulture:** National average retail prices of different markets in the country for horticultural crops changed at different rates. Price for pineapple and onion increased by 1 percent. while prices for water melon, green pepper and cucumber decreased by 5, 3 and 2 percent respectively.

✓ **Coffee:** Up to the week ending 7th May, 2021 total sales were **69,237 tons** with a total value of **USD 136.3 Million.**
