CALL FOR YOUTH AND WOMEN IN CROP PRODUCTION TO APPLY FOR GRANT AND SOFT LOAN THROUGH THE BUILDING A BETTER TOMORROW (BBT) PROGRAM

The Government is aware of the challenges faced by the youth and women in the agriculture sector,includinglack of access to agricultural land, capital, technology and market. The Government has initiated a special program known as Building a Better Tomorrow – Youth Initiative for Agribusiness (BBT-YIA) to address youth and women challenges in the agriculture sector, including access to finance.

The Government, through the Agricultural Input Trust Fund (AGITF), has established a special program for the provision of financial services to youth and women engaged in crop farming. Through the program, the Government has allocated funds for grants and soft loans for women and youth involved in commercial crop value chains. This initiative aims to address challenges in the respective value chain undertaken by youth and women in crop production activities, value addition and marketing of agricultural produce.

Applicant Qualifications:

- (i) Must be a Tanzanian youth aged 18-40 years;
- (ii) Should have experience in agricultural activities, and at the time of application submission, must be actively engagedin an agricultural enterprise;
- (iii) Should be using land that is either your own, your family's, or rented (with specific conditions for those who are renting)
